There is great concern about speeding vehicles in Nedging Road by residents living there. A 20mph limit was suggested, also a Quiet Lane, although no funding is available for this. Speed Watch will be in place over the two weekends when Ipswich Road is closed.

It was agreed to speak to County Cllr Robert Lindsay regarding the speeding problems at the next Parish Council Meeting.
