

## Naughton St Mary Report

A total of 17 services took place at Naughton St Mary during 2024 with 322 attendees (slightly up from 311 in 2023). Types of services were:

- Morning Prayer
- Communion
- Harvest Festival
- Remembrance
- Carol Service
- Celebration of Life

There were no Christenings or weddings during 2024.

Four PCC meetings are held each year. The PCC is delighted that, since her appointment in October last year, Rev Nicola Tindall has attended PCC meetings to provide us with valuable guidance and leadership.

At the APCM held in April this year, Kay Pratt, Martin Pratt, Hayley De Villier and Liz O'Connell continued to serve on the PCC. Carole Homer continued in her role as Church Warden, and Liz O'Connell took on the role of Deputy Warden to support Carole, and to stand in when she is away. Neil O'Connell continued as Church Treasurer. Kay continues to act as Nominal Roll Officer and supported the Suffolk Historic Churches Trust cycle ride that raised over £200 for Naughton St Mary in September 2024.

The 2025 Naughton May Fayre was held, as usual, on Bank Holiday Monday. In spite of the unpredictable weather that day we had a great turn out with over 500 people attending, and raised almost £5200 which will go a long way to covering the Naughton Church Parish Share. As well as being the main fundraising event, it is one that brings the whole community together for a day of fun.
